

u3 is a major chord with ut=do as root. The 3 shows that it is a chord rather than a melody note and is dropped if there are other signs e.g. u7. In chord symbols there are two ways to indicate a minor chord Cm or C-. The latter is used in this context to avoid confusion with the note mi. The chord u/m is a major triad with root ut with the single note mi in the bass. u5 is a chord with no 3rd (bar 19).
